Radiant Power Corp. Achieves RIPS FAA-TSO Approval

Sarasota, FL November 17, 2009 – Radiant Power Corp. of Sarasota, FL has been granted the first-ever Technical Standards Order (“TSO”) approval for the Recorder Independent Power Supply (“RIPS”), which is mandated for service on all aircraft cockpit voice recorders in accordance with TSO C-155 for commercial aircraft. The Radiant RIPS interfaces to all ARINC 757 / 767 CVR designs to ensure continued recording after normal aircraft power ceases.

This lightweight unit, which is available for both commercial and military applications, supports cockpit voice, image and data recording. Versions are also available to meet the multiple form factors and performance characteristics defined in the FAA mandate.
